



TWIN BEAR

Cabernet Sauvignon | v. 2021

The 2021 Twin Bear Cabernet Sauvignon captures the power and finesse of Cabernet grown in Walla Walla Valley. Aromas of sweet cherry and violet lead into layered flavors of dark chocolate, wild blueberry, and ripe plum, with a subtle lift of red currant. The region's distinctive combination of warm days and cool nights enhances ripeness and structure, creating a wine with depth and vibrancy. Silky yet firm tannins are seamlessly woven with refined oak, adding polish to the wine's rich mid-palate. The finish is broad and mouth-filling, leaving a lasting impression of dark fruit, cocoa, and a hint of spice.

For this limited-production wine, grapes were sourced from Heather Hill Vineyard, located along the southwestern reaches of the Walla Walla Valley AVA. Its soil, aspect, and growing conditions provide expressive fruit of exceptional quality, prized for producing wines of remarkable balance, intensity, and age-worthiness.

Handpicked grapes were de-stemmed, carefully sorted to ensure optimal berry selection, and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Regular punch-downs during fermentation helped achieve full extraction. Aged 32 months in new Taransaud French oak barrels.
